<p>Silversmithing Class <i>with Kristina Malcolm</i></p>	<p>Feb. 2 - March 8 Thursdays, 6 - 9 p.m. GHS Art Room #148</p>	<p>(No experience necessary) Learn traditional silversmithing techniques; fabricate a custom sized ring and band and a hand-made, concave formed bezel to set a cabochon (not faceted) gemstone. Ages: High School - Adult Fee: \$90, plus an additional materials fee of \$153 (or greater) payable to the instructor the first night of class</p>
<p>Beginning Juggling <i>with Gerard Neugebauer</i></p>	<p>Feb. 11- March 17 Saturdays, 10:30 am - 12:00 p.m. Green Primary School Cafeteria</p>	<p>Learn basic three-ball patterns in this beginning class.
